Answers to Page 71; your answers need to be close, not exact

1. Jesus and his disciples were walking away from the temple. One of the disciples pointed out the scene of the buildings behind them.
2. *The signs will be similar to those in the Old Testament. There will be rumors of wars, battles, famines, earthquakes, and false Christs.
*Christ's coming will be visible. He will come on the clouds and gather his people. The natural order of the sun, moon, and stars will be disrupted.
*Jesus said that no one knows the time of his coming, not even the angels in heaven. Only God the Father knows when Jesus will return in glory.
3. We are to keep watch, for we don't know the hour of his return. We are to be responsible servants, caring for the world until he comes. We can care for the

world in many ways, such as; by recycling cans and newspapers; by using fewer foam and plastic cups, plates, etc.; and by using trash for a compost pile. We are also to be responsible servants by showing obedience to authority figures, such as parents, teachers, and police officers.

1. Here we see Jesus observing one of the ordinances of the time...the feast of unleavened bread (the Passover). Jesus' example teaches us something today. Remember Jesus knows he is about to die on the cross for our sins. The day he is to be arrested is here. But instead of putting off the observing of the passover, He goes ahead and observes it with his disciples. How many times do we want to put off one of the observances we have, prayer, church, worship, the Lord's Supper. But here we see Jesus showing us that these things are important no matter what is going on in your life and must not be neglected. As we head into the Easter holiday, let's not neglect the spiritual observances of the day!

2. Next we see something important. The verse says that he was having the feast of unleavened bread with the 12 disciples! What? That means Judas is there too. Really? At this late date and time, Judas had either already talked to the authorities about turning Jesus over to them, or at the very least had already made a plan to do so. And Jesus knows this! But he gives no indication of it. He just loves Judas just like he does the other eleven. A lesson to us is to remember this. Jesus still knows the past, present, and future. He knows who will accept him and who will reject him. He knows who will sin and what sin they will commit. And yet he still loves us! This picture of Jesus sharing this important religious feast with Judas is a blessing to us today. Because we can have the assurance that Jesus loves us...not because of who we are or aren't but because of who He is!

3. Next we see Jesus giving them specific instructions on how the feast was to be carried out. This serves two things. First it shows that Jesus truly does know the future. So when he tells them things to come, he can be believed. Remember some horrible things are about to happen. He knows the disciples will have a hard time with these things. He is trying to remind them that he is in control and for them to trust his words. Second is similar. He gives them step-by-step directions, because it is going to be very important, in the weeks that follow his death, that they obey his directions exactly. The disciples will be in danger after his death. But also, they are about to see him after he has risen and he will be with them. He wants them to know they can trust him and still follow him.

4. Last thing we see is that the disciples followed Jesus' directions and found things exactly as he said they would. The lesson for us is that if we follow Jesus' directions exactly we will not be disappointed. This is why we teach you to pray about everything! Talk to Jesus first and listen to his voice. Read the Bible and follow it. No matter what is going on around you. Jesus was facing certain death and separation from God for the first and only time in eternity. He is about to encounter what it is like to be a sinner in hell, with his soul void of anything from God. Remember the outward agony we see his body go through is a reminder to us of inwardly what his soul is going through. So no matter what, follow Jesus. No matter if there is a pandemic, follow Jesus. No matter if there is COVID-19, spend time with Jesus in worship. No matter what!
